Program Description :

Students enrolled in the MSc (Physics) program may take the Co-operative option subject to the approval of the Department. To obtain the MSc (Physics Co-operative Option) degree the student must satisfy all the academic requirements for the MSc (Physics) degree and in addition must complete Physics 5990 and 5992 successfully. The first and last terms of the student's program must be academic, and at least one of the work-terms must occur in a fall or winter session. The student may have the opportunity to work on a thesis during work-term placements.

Admission Requirement :

- Applicants for admission must be graduates of a recognized university, college, or institute as well as show evidence of scholarly achievement. Except where otherwise stated in the Admission Requirements of a particular program, degree students must have a four year bachelor's degree or its equivalent with at least second class standing (B) based on their last 20 half courses or equivalent.
- An applicant holding a degree other than one in the discipline area to which admission is sought will be considered on the basis of courses taken and academic standing. A Qualifying Year at the undergraduate level may be required to meet the admission standards. Courses taken as part of a Qualifying Year can not be used as credit towards a graduate degree.

General Checklist :

1. Non Refundable Application Fees:- 100 CAD (Payable by Credit card)
2. RESUME:- Detailed resume on yourself including your academic qualification/ your achievements/ your goals/ hobbies/ work experience/ any certifications for example any IT certificates from Microsoft etc details.

* All the above information must be verified with Institution/Country Website

3. WORK EXPERIENCE LETTER (if applicable):- These letters have to be on the letter head of the company stating the number of years you have worked for the company/ your profile/ your performance. It has to be signed and stamped by the company authority.

4. PASSPORT:- Front and back side.

5. International English language Testing System (IELTS) or Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) Result:- if appeared

6. Graduate Studies Reference Form (3 forms required) :-

- An electronic reference form will be automatically sent by email to the reference you identify on the graduate studies application form.
- This form is requested in support of the applicant's ability to undertake advanced study and research.

7. OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT REQUIREMENTS:-

1. One official copy of your complete academic record must be submitted to the Office of Graduate Studies directly from the Institution(s) attended bearing the official seal of those institution(s). If your degree from those institution(s) is currently in progress, please submit the transcripts of your course work to date. Admitted students will not be allowed to register until their final official transcripts have been received.

2. For a transcript to be accepted by Lakehead university, it MUST:-

- Be an official document in your native language.
- Be signed by an official of that institution.
- Bear the seal of the institution.
- If the documents which you are submitting are not in English, you will be required to provide notarized.

3. English translations together with copies of the original documents

- Be sent directly from the institution to Lakehead University or sent by the applicant in an envelope sealed by the institution.

4. Your transcript should contain:-

- A list of courses taken and the grades/marks received, by year level.
- The number of semesters and years that you have studied in the institution
- The grading scheme by the institution
- The diploma(s)/degree(s) granted to you by the institution

5. OFFICIAL PROOF OF DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

- If your degree has been completed, you must submit official proof that your degree has been awarded or conferred. Admitted students will not be allowed to register until their final official transcripts have been received.
- If your final official transcripts includes the name of the degree you have been awarded or conferred and the date upon which the degree has been awarded or conferred, this will be considered official proof of degree.
- If your final official transcript does not include the above information, you are required to submit separate official documentation from

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your institution as proof of degree. The document must indicate the name of the degree awarded or conferred and the date upon which the degree has been awarded or conferred.

- Provisional certificates will not be accepted as proof of degree.

6. FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS:- Latest 2 years Income Tax Returns of Sponsor (Parents), Parents Work Letters and Latest 6 months bank statement.
