No entry from high school. 60 General University level credits with an overall GPA of 2.67. 60 credits must consist of: SOWK 110 and SOWK 210, CMNS 155 or ENGL 105, three credits of English literature, SOWK 225 or PSYC 250, three credits of introductory statistics, and 42 additional Arts and Science credits; Minimum of 400 hours of related paid or volunteer work experience.
