Admission Requirement :

Academic Requirements:

- A four-year Honours degree in Economics (not Business) with an average of at least B+ (upper second-class) at Dalhousie standards.
- original transcripts of all previous academic work
- 2 academic letters of reference
- completion of the MA - Economics Course Requirement Form
- a short personal statement of interest (approximately 1 page)
- proof of English language proficiency. Requirement waived for applicants from India who have completed a degree at a recognized university where the language of instruction is English.
